

Rules for Costume class

Costume class is supposed to be a fun class, where horses and handlers can be dressed according to a chosen theme.

Coloring of (parts) of the horse and safe constructions of costume on the horse allowed for this class only. Please check products on safety for use on /with horses.

This is a freestyle class. The following procedure is followed, walk in all together in collective presentation at secure distance of other horses and leave arena at sign of ringmaster. Individual presentation, in order of number, is up to the handler, you can choose to trot in at lead, or you can present the horse in Liberty/freedom. If the horse is shown in liberty, it should not take over 90 seconds to catch the horse again at risk of DQ. Horses has to be stand in front of the judges. Handlers will leave the arena at sign of ring steward.

Scoring on originality and use of theme, harmony with horse and movements of the horse. Points by 100 pro item

Safety is very important! Horses have to be under control of the handlers. We advise participants not to use stallions for this class! The ringmaster and DC will have full authority do withdraw horses from this class at their own discretion based on animal welfare or safety! Dangerous behavior or unruly horses can lead to disqualification!
